Welcome to the sixth annual **KY Proud Fall CSA Week**! Thank you for joining us to learn more about Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) programs across Kentucky. Use this guide to explore different CSA models, share types, and farms offering CSA programs near you!

WHAT IS CSA?

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a local farm subscription you sign up for ahead of time. Members pay a portion of the share upfront, which helps the farm pay for seeds, labor, and equipment. In return, CSA shareholders get regular access to the freshest items from the farm and share in the season's risks and rewards.

CSA MEMBER PERKS

CSA makes it convenient to access locally sourced foods while supporting Kentucky farms. Members can pick up their share at several locations, including a neighborhood pickup, a nearby farmers market, or home delivery. They often receive farm newsletters, recipes, and opportunities to stay connected to their farm.

CSA SIGNUP TIPS

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CHOOSE A CSA SHARE SIZE THAT'S RIGHT FOR YOU

Determine the best share size for your household based on how many items you want and how many times you cook at home. CSA farms typically offer various share sizes (small, regular, extra-large) and sometimes different delivery frequencies (weekly, bi-weekly, monthly), which makes CSA programs more flexible for different household sizes and schedules. Check each farm's website for share-size descriptions and delivery options during the season.

PREPARE FOR WHAT WILL BE IN YOUR CSA SHARE

Look for a description of what products the farm grows each season for its CSA program. If certain items are must-haves, contact the farm directly to see whether they will be included in the shares. For produce CSAs, members can expect items to be harvested a few days before pickup and then packed in a box or bag. For meat CSAs, items generally come frozen, are packed in an insulated bag, and can be thawed in the refrigerator for immediate use or stored in the freezer.

SELECT A PAYMENT OPTION THAT FITS YOUR BUDGET

Choose the share payment option that works best for you. Members can often choose to pay in full or in installments. When possible, paying more upfront helps the farm secure critical operating capital early in the season, which is needed to increase production. However, this is not usually required. Several CSA programs offer installment options to better accommodate different budgets.

FIND A CSA PICKUP THAT WORKS FOR YOUR SCHEDULE

Research the farm's pickup options and select the most convenient location, time, and day. CSA shares are typically available for pickup on the farm, at the farmers market, in a neighborhood, or at a business storefront. If none of these options work, some farms also offer home delivery for an additional fee, bringing the CSA share straight to your door. If you're traveling during the season, many farms will also allow a member to pause their share and receive extra items in a future week.

CONNECT WITH A FARM

CSA SUBSCRIPTION TYPES

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TRADITIONAL CSA

In this model, customers pay the farmer upfront for a share of the harvest over a set number of weeks. Each week, the farm selects the freshest available items and packs them into a box or makes them available for pickup at a designated location.

CUSTOMIZABLE CSA

Like a traditional CSA, the key difference is more flexibility. Before pickup, customers can adjust their share by swapping items, adding or removing items, and typically pausing during vacation through their online CSA member account.

MARKET STYLE CSA

This is similar to a traditional CSA, but instead of receiving a pre-packed box, members visit the farm's stand and choose their own items. It combines the flexibility of a farmers market with the commitment of a CSA.

FULL-DIET CSA

This share type generally includes multiple products from a farm or a collaboration of farms that can meet most of a member's household food needs. A full-diet CSA share typically includes produce, meat, eggs, dairy, and more.

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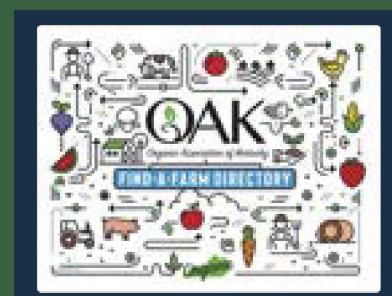
OTHER WAYS TO FIND A CSA
